## Thematic Working Group Meeting on OPS

- **OBJECTIVE**

The Zambian Government has clearly indicated the importance accorded to the development of civil aviation. Zambia is entering into a phase of intensive activities to further advance this progress; it is imperative that the challenges faced are evident to all the parties engaged in these exciting developments.

This OPS thematic meeting follows on from an AOC WORKSHOP to be held on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> December, and will address the target group of current and potential AOC holders, with emphasis on their Operations' related activities.

The meeting presents an opportunity for the industry and service providers in OPS related activities to engage with the ZCAA, and provide clear indicators of where they believe the Authority can evolve in its secondary role as a facilitator to Zambian Civil Aviation progress.

The outcomes of this activity are:

A greater, and shared, understanding of the issues faced by service providers operating under the regulatory environment of the ZCAA

The key topics covered will be:

1. Related to the outcome of the AOC workshop, examining issues in the OPS sphere identified as problematic during this activity.
2. Emphasis will be placed on relating the development of a Safety Management System to the oversight requirements of the Regulator.
3. The certification of advanced ops specs.
4. Themes for this meeting should be driven by the participants.
